Sheila Dillon serves the City of Boston as Chief of Housing and Director of the Department of Neighborhood Development (DND). As a member of Mayor Martin J. Walsh's Cabinet, she acts as an advisor to Mayor Walsh on housing issues in the city, including the execution of the Walsh Administration's housing plan *Housing a Changing City: Boston 2030*. She also is a member of the team implementing Mayor Walsh's *Action Plan to End Veteran and Chronic Homelessness in Boston 2015-2018*. She oversees the management of DND's Boston Home Center, the Neighborhood Housing Development team, and Real Estate Management and Sales team. In addition, she leads the administration's newly-formed Office of Housing Stability, which is charged with protecting residents' tenancies in Boston's fast-moving real estate market.
