HOUSING DEVELOPMENT AND PRESERVATION



500+

residents provided with safe and affordable homes

- 300+ homes maintained
- 25 program partners collaborated to improve the City's housing policy

EDUCATION AND WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

460 people accessed education and job opportunities



- 275 job seekers and over 40 hiring employers attended 2 career fairs
- 50 people gained job readiness skills to successfully participate in the labor force
- 50 participants received one hour of employment counseling
- 30 people secured full-time positions
- 25 people advanced their education by obtaining certificates
- 15 people worked part-time
- 15 people registered with employment agencies

IMPROVING LIVES THROUGH SOCIAL SERVICES

307 people served to improve their economic security

- 60 people accessed health care services (25 for mental health counseling; 15 for asthma prevention; 20 for health insurance)
- 50 people received referrals and counseling to access social benefits
- 40 people registered for food pantries
- 30 people were assisted in accessing food stamps
- 15 people applied for childcare and 6 were eligible for vouchers
- 10 families secured YMCA memberships to improve wellbeing
- 2 referrals for domestic violence

DEVELOPING OUR NEIGHBORHOOD THROUGH CIVIC ENGAGEMENT



211

community members engaged through planning and organizing

- 195 people attended 4 community meetings to learn about neighborhood issues
- 9 members of Organizing Committee participated in monthly meetings to discuss issues with short-term rentals, promote tenant rights, and recommend improvements for the City's housing policy
- 7 members of Fenway's Urban Village Committee commented on impact of proposed developments

- 128 members and supporters attended our annual meeting
- 115 residents and 57 businesses participated in our Halloween event
- 35 members enjoyed Salsa Dance
- 25 people enjoyed Mother's Day Jazz Brunch
- 10 parents participated in Fenway Family Coalition meetings
- 5 residents joined the Latino Community Meeting
